## Sailing School Spring & Summer 2019 Course Schedule

May 13, 2019

### Basic Keelboat Cruising (Sail Canada Basic Cruising Standard)

(Course dates below)

Course fee: \$740 + HST

**Objective:** Upon completion of this course you should be able to sail a keelboat of up to 10 metres safely and efficiently in moderate wind and sea conditions by day. Your on-water ability will be assessed against the afloat skills required for the Sail Canada Basic Cruising Standard. Classroom lectures will prepare you for the written ashore knowledge Sail Canada exam.

**Note:** Students have the option of writing the Pleasure Craft Operator's Card exam during this course. There is an additional fee for the PCOC.

#### Features:

- 18 hours of on-water instruction on a 6 – 10 metre keelboat
- Classroom theory (ashore knowledge) sessions
- Training offered in two formats: 5-day (Mon-Fri, includes theory) or 2 on-water weekends + a **theory weekend\***
- Sail Canada textbook and pre-course package
- Logbook and Sail Canada seal upon successful completion
- Taught by Sail Canada certified instructors
- Includes:
  - Safety equipment and procedures
  - Boat handling under power and sail
  - Commands and terminology
  - Basic weather and chart reading
  - Crew-overboard procedures
  - Undocking, Docking and anchoring
  - Reefing and knots
  - Rules of the road

#### Required Supplies:

- Students are required to wear a properly fitted, approved PFD with a whistle at all times when on the boat and on HBSC docks (bring your own or use a PFD provided by the school)
- It is recommended that students in the 5-day (Monday – Friday) courses bring a box lunch
- Required clothing:
  - Deck shoes, white-soled running shoes or other non-marking shoes
  - Windproof / waterproof jacket or foul weather gear
  - Sun hat or cap and sunscreen
  - Soft-sided bag with water, snacks and extra clothing for hot, cool, wet or windy conditions

#### **IYT Bareboat Skipper with ICC live aboard course**

(Monday – Friday, July 1 – 4) **One space left!!**

Course fee: \$1,250 + HST. The cost of food is not included.

The International Bareboat Skipper course is a five-day course. It is not for beginners and the **recommended** entry level requirements are a VHF maritime radio operator’s certificate, and to have logged over 200 nautical miles and 10 days at sea before advancing to this level. The recommended minimum age to obtain this certification is 18. Candidates who do not have 200 nautical miles may take this course and gain miles required to obtain certification during the course.

Those who have obtained the International Bareboat Skipper qualification, can automatically obtain the “International Certificate of Competency” (ICC).

#### **VHF Radio “Restricted Operator’s Certificate (Maritime)” with DSC Endorsement**

(Monday & Thursday evenings, 18:30 – 21:30, May 27/30, Jun 17/20, Jul 15/18, Aug 12/15, Sep 9/12)

Course fee: \$135 + HST

Learn to operate a VHF (very high frequency) radio legally and obtain the necessary certificate. This two-evening course covers all aspects of marine VHF radio operation. On the second evening, students will undergo a brief oral examination

and written test to obtain the VHF ROC(M) certificate with Digital Selective Calling (DSC) Endorsement. Register early to receive study material in advance.

### **Powered Vessel Operators Permit (Toronto Harbour License)**

(Thursday evenings, 18:30 – 20:30, May 16, Jun 13, Jul 11, Aug 8, Sep 5)

Course fee: \$90 + HST

Take the written exam and demonstrate simple boat handling skills using HBSC's powerboat to obtain your Powered Vessel Operator's Permit (Toronto Harbour License). This is not an instructional course. Students will demonstrate simple on the water boat handling skills aboard a small powerboat and write a short test. You are welcome to arrive early to practice manoeuvring the powerboat. Register early to receive study material in advance.

### **Basic Keelboat Starter Package**

(See Basic Keelboat Cruising schedule)

Package price: \$1,440 + HST

The Basic Keelboat Starter Package includes one Basic Keelboat Cruising course (see course description and dates above) plus the Restricted Operator's Certificate (Maritime) VHF radio course, Ports Toronto Powered Vessel Operator's Permit (Toronto Harbour License) evaluation and a month in our boat-share Sailing Club.

1. **The Basic Keelboat Cruising Course** (Sail Canada Basic Cruising Standard) – Please see above for complete description and course dates.
2. **The VHF Radio Operators Certificate** will be taught over two evenings and will cover all aspects of marine VHF radio operation as outlined above.
3. **Powered Vessel Operator's Permit (Toronto Harbour License)** is a one evening event that, upon successful completion, entitles you to operate a motorized vessel within the boundaries of Toronto Harbour. Please see above for more details.
4. **The Humber Bay Sailing Centre boat-share sailing club** will be available to you for one month within the sailing season (May 1 – end of September) at a time of your choosing. The club is an excellent way to enhance your sailing skills and gain experience on our fleet of cruising sailboats that range in length from 24 feet to 34 feet, while meeting other likeminded individuals. You will be able to book online and sail with other members at your convenience. Mentoring on Tuesdays and Thursdays evenings as well as racing on selected evenings all serve to enhance your skills and enjoyment.

Purchased separately these would total \$1,665 + HST.

### **Intermediate Keelboat Cruising "Afloat Skills" (Sail Canada Intermediate Cruising Standard)**

(Course dates below)

Course fee: \$1,135 5-day course. HST is extra. Cost of food is not included.

**Objective:** Upon completion of this course you should be able to cruise safely and efficiently on a sloop-rigged sailing yacht of up to 12 metres in moderate wind and sea conditions by day. This course emphasizes on-the-water skills at a level acceptable for bare boat chartering for extended cruises in coastal waters. Your on-water ability will be assessed against the afloat skills required for the Sail Canada Intermediate Cruising Standard. On board or classroom lectures will prepare you for the written ashore knowledge Sail Canada exam.

**Prerequisites for certification:** Basic Cruising Standard, Basic Coastal Navigation, ROC(M) VHF w/DSC endorsement, Pleasure Craft Operator's Card. Prior sailing experience as a skipper is also recommended. *It is also recommended that the Sail Canada Intermediate Cruising "Ashore Knowledge" (theory) course be completed prior to undertaking the Afloat Skills course.*

**International Certificate of Competency (ICC) on-water evaluation**

(Wednesdays and Sundays, May 18, 22, Jun 15, 19, Jul 10, 20, Aug 7, 10, Sep 14, 25

... or ON YOUR BOAT on a mutually agreed date)

Evaluation Fee: \$180:00 + HST

This evaluation is conducted as a “challenge” wherein you, *the experienced sailor*, demonstrate your sailing abilities to the instructor and are evaluated against the ICC requirements. The skills involved include successfully demonstrating the following: preparation for sea and mechanical checklist, departing from the dock – springing off, securing to a buoy and anchoring, knot tying – bowline, clove hitch & reef knot, crew overboard procedures – triangle/figure 8 method or quick stop method or broad reach/close reach method, 360 degree turn, alongside skills - communication, use of lines and fenders, springing on, Boat handling under sail – tacking, gybing, heaving to, boat handling under power – correct use of speed and control while manoeuvring, vessel Handling (general) – communication, knowledge of the buoyage system and COLREGS.
